Selected Achievements:

In CIB LOB of JPMorgan Chase Bank under GIAM Get to Moderate program successfully achieved 96% target for Interactive Application IDs and 92% target App2App IDs (total 12K Functional IDs of 127 applications) migration to enterprise level security standard solutions like Kerberos Authentication and Enterprise Password Vault. (EPV CARKaim agent installation) This effort enabled JPMC to close more than 1200 compliance break opened from 2018.

Oversaw a portfolio of projects for JP Morgan Chase valued at \$20MM including launching the first-ever automated deployment to cloud-based platform and leading a 500 distributed server build impacting over 50MM customers.

Led 3 different cross-functional Scrum Teams totaling 18+ employees in the JPMC Digital Nucleus, successfully increasing velocity from 20+ points to 35+ points in under 10 sprints while delivering projects on-time and underbudget.

Implemented new Data on Edge initiative in the Digital Nucleus space, increasing resiliency, reducing response time by 40ms, and decreasing failures by ~30,000.

Spearheaded a series of cost optimization initiatives, including identifying less CPU consuming microservices and bringing them to the cloud for a \$170,000 savings and decommissioning legacy hardware, saving over \$242,000.

Trained internal and external product owners and tech leads on Agile and Scrum best practices, holding 4 major coaching sessions serving 18+ employees and working one-on-one with 6 individuals to implement improvements.

Initiated a variety of scrum & agile process optimizations, leading 2 development teams of more than 9 employees to implement sprint plans, relative estimations, continuous integration and more, leading to receipt of company-wide 2016 Annual Leadership Value Award.

Led major cost optimization initiatives, including the migration of American Express Offer DB2 Database to a big data hive, saving over \$200,000/year and mainframe component optimization which saved over \$87,000/year.

Implemented new processes which reduced the number of automated incidents tickets by 32% by reserving 20% capacity for the existing production and by applying problem solving techniques.

Oversaw the Card Acceptance and Processing Network (CAPN) portfolio for American Express, valued at \$2.5MM, acting as a solution architect to improve 16 FINCAP layouts to a single global settlement layout, saving over \$5MM.

Received the “Best Innovation Idea Award” for CAPN portfolio work and overall commitment to process improvements and cost optimizations which increased efficiency, expanded margins, and increased revenue for American Express.
